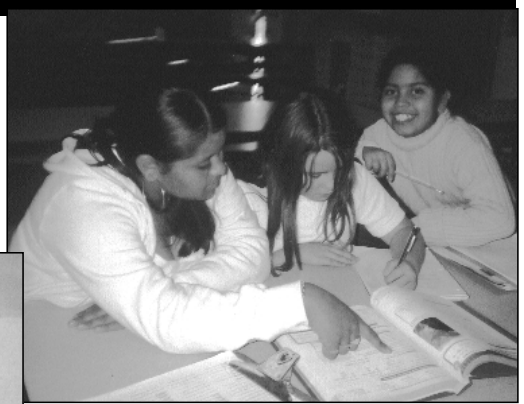

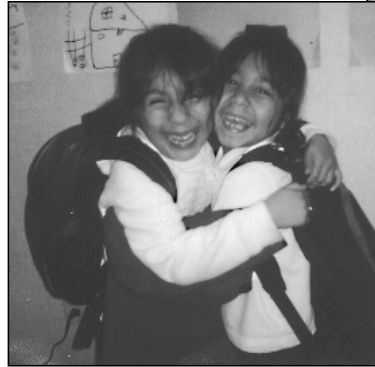


“What I have learned in CPY is to make friends. If you be a friend you get a friend. I try to be a better person rather than a mean person. If you give respect to others you will get it in return.”

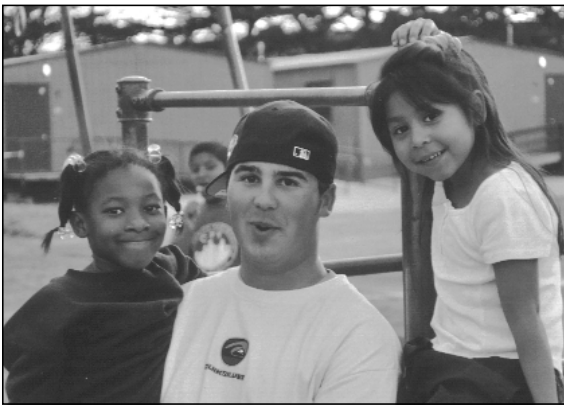

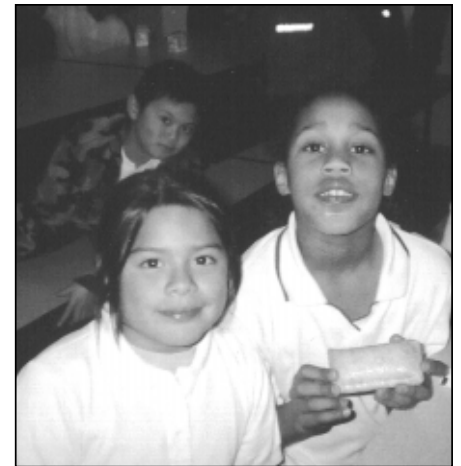
“What I’ve learned in CPY is to not bite kids. I’ve also learned to respect by not cutting in line.”
